



Calling for an election on August 17, 2010  
to restore the District's regular levy rate  
to \$0.50 per thousand dollars of assessed value

WHEREAS, North Olympic Library Systems is a library district duly organized and existing under and by the virtue of the constitution and laws of the State of Washington, hereafter referred to as "District"; and

WHEREAS pursuant to RCW 84.55.050, the District may levy a regular property tax in excess of the levy limitations contained in RCW Chapter 84.55, when such levy amount is authorized by a proposition approved by a majority of the voters of the District voting on the proposition at a general or special election held within the District; and

WHEREAS there is substantial need to provide continued funding for the maintenance and operation of the District, and it is deemed necessary for the District to restore its regular levy rate to \$0.50 per thousand dollars of assessed value upon all the taxable property within the District in 2010 for collection in 2011, thus increasing its regular property tax levy in excess of the limit factor provided for in RCW Chapter 84.55; and thereafter using such levy to compute limitations for subsequent years; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the District (the "Board") deems it necessary to place the proposition of whether or not the District shall levy regular property taxes in 2010, for collection in 2011, in excess of the limit factor provided for in RCW Chapter 84.55 before the qualified electors of the District; and

WHEREAS, it is further deemed advisable that said propositions be submitted to such electors at the primary election to be held within the District on August 17, 2010;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

*Section 1:* The Board hereby finds and declares that, there is a substantial need to provide for continued funding for the maintenance and operation of the North Olympic Library System, and it is necessary for the District to restore its regular levy rate to \$0.50 per thousand of assessed value upon all the taxable property within the District in 2010, for collection in 2011, thus increasing its regular property tax levy in excess of the limit factor provided for in RCW Chapter 84.55, and thereafter using such levy to compute limitations for subsequent years.

*Section 2:* The Board hereby finds and declares that the welfare of the residents of the District requires the Board to submit to the voters of the District, for their approval or rejection, the proposition of whether or not the District shall restore its regular levy rate to \$0.50 per thousand of assessed value upon all the taxable property within the District in 2010, for collection in 2011, thus increasing its regular property tax levy in excess of the limit factor provided for in RCW Chapter 84.55, in order to provide for continued funding for the normal maintenance and operation of the North Olympic Library System; and upon

the approving vote of the majority of the voters of the District voting on such proposition, the District shall be authorized to do so.

*Section 3:* The Board hereby finds and declares that the voters of the District at the primary election to be held on August 17, 2010, be submitted the proposition of whether or not the District shall restore its regular levy rate to \$0.50 per thousand dollars of assessed value upon all the taxable property within the District in 2010, for collection in 2011, thus increasing its regular property tax levy in excess of the limit factor provided for in RCW Chapter 84.55, in order to provide continued funding for the normal maintenance and operation of the North Olympic Library system.

*Section 4:* The Clallam County Auditor, as ex officio Supervisor of Elections, is hereby requested to call and conduct said election to be held within the District on August 17, 2010, and to submit to the qualified electors of the District the proposition in substantially the following form:

The Board of Trustees of the North Olympic Library System District adopted Resolution 10-04-03 concerning the financing of library maintenance and operations. If passed, this proposition would authorize the District to restore its 2010 property tax levy rate from \$0.33 to \$0.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value for collection in 2011, which amount will be used for computing legal limits on levies in subsequent years. Should this proposition be approved?






*Section 6:* The Board determines that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


