This winter, the North Olympic Library System (NOLS) is offering three chances to race the clock and other puzzle teams at the Port Angeles Main Library, 2210 S. Peabody St. Jigsaw puzzle contests start at 10 a.m. sharp on the second Saturday of the month, Jan. 13, Feb. 10 and March 9.

Puzzle teams of up to four people will be provided with a 500-piece jigsaw puzzle to complete within two hours. Prizes will be awarded to the team that finishes the puzzle first. If no puzzles are completed during the contest, the team with the fewest pieces remaining will be declared the winner. The puzzles are in a variety of designs, so teams can come back and try a different puzzle at each contest.

Adults, teens, and children ages 10 and older are invited to compete. Bring your own team or join up with others at the event.
