Re:	Free computer classes at Port Angeles Main Library

The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) offers free computer classes from 5 to 6:30 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday of the month, Jan. 23 through Oct. 22, at the Port Angeles Main Library, 2210 S. Peabody St. In November, the class meets on the third Tuesday, Nov. 19. The classes are part of the Northstar Digital Literacy Program that assists people interested in learning how to complete general tasks using a computer. Participants can sign up for one or multiple classes. Registration is required in advance. Call 360-417-8500, visit the library, or sign up online at nols.org/northstar.

During each 90-minute class, NOLS staff will help participants learn at their own pace, whether they are looking to brush up on computer skills or learn how to use the computer for the first time. Content is based on the needs and interest of attendees and can range from how to use a mouse to how to build an Excel spreadsheet. Laptops will be provided, though attendees are encouraged to bring a laptop if they have one.
