Re: Open call for Eco Art in the Library



The North Olympic Library System (NOLS) invites people living on the Olympic Peninsula to submit artwork inspired by environmental conservation for the Eco Art in the Library exhibition that will be displayed in the Port Angeles Main Library, 2210 S. Peabody St. Online applications at nols.org/eco-art will be accepted through Earth Day, Monday, April 22.

Adults, teens, and children of all artistic experience levels are encouraged to enter. The exhibition is part of the all-ages Summer Reading Program. This year's theme is Read, Renew, Repeat! Creative work in any format and medium will be considered – from nature-inspired finger painting to sculpture, video, poetry, and more. Materials can include found and recycled objects.

The exhibition opens with a reception on Friday, June 21, at the Port Angeles Main Library and remains on view through Saturday, Aug. 24. Selected artists can drop off work June 15 and 17 and may choose to list their artwork for sale; the Library does not charge or take a commission.
